

## ALGONQUIN RESIDENTS:

Damuth Trane will be here on **Monday, April 5<sup>th</sup>** working most of the day to turn on the cooling system for the season.

Summer is right around the corner!

### Here are some important reminders:

Check and make sure your fan coil unit fans are turned on (low, medium or high) to help move the air. Otherwise, the fan coil units will be cool but the cooled air will not be circulating in your Unit. Also, be sure to check your thermostat settings. You may have had them turned all the way down during the winter when there was enough ambient heat in the building that you did not want heat from your fan coil units.

If you like your Unit warmer, then turn the thermostats up to 75 degrees or higher to keep the air conditioning from coming on.

If the temperature outside is above 70 degrees, air conditioning will be on. Between 67 and 70 degrees, the system is in “transition”, and neither heat nor air conditioning is on. “Transition” typically takes a couple of hours.

Remember also that the system is designed so there is only heat on, or air conditioning on, or neither when it is in transition. It is not capable of providing heat to some and air conditioning to others at the same time.
