Register for Your COVID-19 Vaccine

Please don't dump your loose trash or garbage down the chute or into the dumpster. Our Rules & Regulations require that all trash be securely bagged. Putting loose trash (even in a paper grocery bag) down the chute is dangerous and messy. Loose trash in the dumpster gets scattered when the dumpster is dumped in the dump truck. We had trash floating in the Lafayette River inlet that had to be retrieved. This is a waste of maintenance staff time.

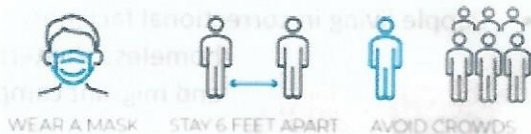
Reminder – Face Coverings in the Hallways

When wearing a face mask make sure your nose is covered. COVID droplets exit and enter through the nose as much as through the mouth.

Face coverings are required when going to the trash chute, doing your laundry, or just going to another floor. When walking down the hallway, dangling your mask from your ear does not protect you or your neighbors

You may have COVID and not show symptoms. Please keep your neighbors safe.

Face coverings are *required* for all common areas – ALL residents and visitors – unless you have a medical condition and cannot wear one.
